The Hill School's mathematics department has designed its own integrated approach to all mathematics courses leading to calculus and statistics. All of our faculty serve as athletic coaches or co-curricular program leaders.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND QUALIFICATIONS

Ideally, a candidate will possess at least 3 years of experience teaching mathematics at the secondary school level in a variety of courses. Other skills and/ or qualities necessary for this position are: effective verbal and written communication skills; a genuine willingness to work closely with students and colleagues; a high energy level; and, of course, a good and enduring sense of humor! A bachelor's degree in Mathematics is required; a master's degree is preferred. Start date for this position is mid-August 2023.
